

- ❖ **Survey name: Crisis monitoring survey - wave I, 2010**
- ❖ **Partners:**
 - World Bank
- ❖ **Principal Investigator:** Alexey Pamporov
- ❖ **Fieldwork period: March 2010**
- ❖ **Population (main):** Households, living in Bulgaria.
- ❖ **Main sample model:** Two-stage cluster sample, number of clusters: **240**
- ❖ **Main sample realization:** Interviews planned - in 2400 households, interviews realized - in **2383** households. Data is collected for **6653** household members.
- ❖ **Maximal stochastic error:** $\pm 2,01\%$ for proportion 50% and 95% confidence interval (inner-cluster correlation is not taken into account)

- ❖ **Population (booster):** Households, living in segregated neighborhoods in Bulgaria.
- ❖ **Booster sample model:** Random sample of all segregated neighborhoods with probability of selection proportional to the number of population
- ❖ **Booster sample realization:** Interviews planned - in 400 households, interviews realized - in **297** households. Data is collected for **1099** household members.
- ❖ **Registration method:** Face to face interview in a standardized questionnaire.
- ❖ **Main topics:**
 - Household structure
 - Employment
 - Migration
 - Housing
 - Household assets
 - Social assistance
 - Unemployment benefits
 - Other social protection
 - Informal transfers
 - Other sources of income
 - Credits
 - Affected by crisis and coping mechanisms
 - Subjective attitudes
